With bilingual guides (English/Spanish), you'll explore the upper and lower circuits, including a guided tour of the breathtaking Devil's Throat Falls. You'll also visit the Triple Frontier, where

Brazil, Paraguay, and Argentina converge, and take a tour of the Brazilian side of the falls. Round-trip transfers to Brazil are included, ensuring a seamless experience.
